



Summary: Study of Educational Material People Newly Diagnosed with Cancer

Inflexxion, a small Boston-area behavioral health education company, has developed an educational CD-ROM for people newly diagnosed with cancer, with funds provided by the National Cancer Institute. The goal of this program is to help patients become more educated health care consumers and more effective in managing their care. Inflexxion is doing a study to test how effective the CD-ROM program is.

We are looking for individuals interested in participating who have been diagnosed with any form of cancer within the last one-year. Participants will be asked to complete paper and pencil or on-line questionnaires about themselves and their experience coping with cancer, and to review educational material about coping with cancer (either a booklet or a CD-ROM program). Participants will complete questionnaires twice more, six weeks and twelve weeks after they have received the educational material. It will take a total of about 3 hours over three months to participate in the study. Participants will be paid \$100.00 for being in the study.

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Study Criteria:

Participants must be over the age of 18, have had an initial diagnosis of cancer made within the past one year. Participants must be able to speak and read English, and have access to a computer.
